We have been very busy tasting wine to bring you some of the most exciting producers and wines from all over the world. Some of our selections are extravagant, but then we think that the best steak money can buy should be accompanied by the very best wines.

### **Andrew Will**

Chris Camarda named the winery after his nephew (Andrew) and his son (Will). His distinctive Bordeaux blends are amongst the finest wines in the US and have helped put Washington State on the world wine map.

#### *Two Blondes 2005*

£50.00

Lengthy and elegant with vibrant concentrated fruit. Raspberry and blueberry pie flavours draw you in and then it opens up showing spicy and earthy complexity.

### **Duckhorn Vineyards**

Duckhorn Vineyards have been producing fantastic Bordeaux varietal wines for over 30 years in the Napa Valley. Their wines were consumed during President Obama's inauguration dinner, a testament to their outstanding quality.

#### *Paraduxx 2006*

£65.00

An awesome blend of Zinfandel and Cabernet Sauvignon making it the ideal partner for our aged steaks.

### **Alban Vineyards**

Only 300 cases of this wine are produced each year making it nigh on impossible to get hold of. Quite simply it is one of the best examples of Grenache in the world and receives top marks from all the most revered wine critics.

#### *Alban Estate Vineyards Grenache 2006*

£160.00

The nose is incredibly perfumed and gets the mouth watering ready for a rich medley of dark concentrated berry fruits on the palette. The finish is never ending.

### **Bodega Noemia**

Hans Vinding and Noemi Cinzano discovered some Malbec vines dating back to the 1930's in the southernmost wine producing region of Argentina. The landowner thought they were mad when they vested an interest in buying the property and producing wine. How wrong he was. They are now producing arguably the best wines to come out of South America.

#### *A Lisa 2008*

£45.00

This wine reflects the cool climates of Patagonia. An altogether more refined Malbec than those produced in the hotter region of Mendoza. This wine oozes class, complexity and finesse.

#### *Bodega Noemia Malbec 2006*

£115.00

The quality of the oak and black fruits prevail on the nose. The palate shows fantastic concentration without extraction. Expect layers of earth and minerals with ripe, fine and chocolatey tannins. Superb.

**Luigi Bosca**

The Arizu family has been producing wines in Mendoza for over 100 years. Their continuous quest for excellence coupled with innovation and experimentation has made them a model for Argentine Wineries. This is a rare chance to taste wines from vines that existed before Phylloxera ravaged most of the world's vineyards. The vines are around 90 years old and stand on their own roots rather than the disease resistant root stock of modern wines.

*Gala 1 2006* £45.00

Sophisticated Malbec blend with Petit Verdot and Tannat. Strong yet elegant with intense red berry fruit and delicate spice. Caresses the palette and has a long finish.

*Finca Los Nobles 2005* £65.00

Malbec and Petit Verdot combine to give a wine of great structure. Plums, coffee, cherries and violets characterize this velvety wine made from 90 year old vines.

*Icono 2006* £130.00

One of Argentina's greatest reds. Superb structure, complexity and balance define this wine. Intense aromas of black fruit and a subtle bouquet of violets precede the complex palette and rich mouthfeel of this stunning red.

**Vega Sicilia**

We felt very lucky when we were offered a small allocation of the wines from this famous estate located in Valbuena de Duero. The wines of Vega Sicilia are some of the finest in the world.

*Bodegas Alion 2004* £75.00

Bodegas Alion was founded 15yrs ago by Vega Sicilia with the express aim of creating a more modern style wine using 100% Tempranillo. Aged for 18 months in new oak this is a real powerhouse.

*Vega Sicilia Unico 1994* £250.00

With an intense ripe cherry colour this wine is full bodied, potent and powerful. An unbelievable vintage and a wine headed for the history books.

**Chateau La Nerthe**

This Chateau is one of the oldest in Chateaufort Du Pape with a history that dates back some 800 years. All 13 varieties of grape used in this most famous of blends are grown organically with the aim to express the terroir fully. Its wines are simply world class and here we take two of their wines from one of the greatest vintages the region has ever seen. This is an extremely rare opportunity to taste them.

*Chateau La Nerthe 1998* £100.00

This wine is making the magical transformation from vibrant fresh fruit flavours to complex coffee and dried spiced fruit. Lovely length, brilliant balance, plenty of power and yet perfectly elegant.

*Chateau La Nerthe 'Cuvee des Cadettes' 1998* £175.00

Undoubtedly one of the greatest wines in the world. A freshness of fruit and yet a meaty maturity characterise this wine. Black and red fruits, herbs and spice combine seamlessly to create a monumental wine.

**Domaine Meo-Camuzet**

Meo-Camuzet is undeniably one of Burgundy's star estates. The famous Henri Mayer rented their vineyards for many years before becoming a mentor figure for the current winemaker Jean-Nicholas Meo.

*Nuits St Georges 2004* £90.00

This wine is incredibly well balanced. It has great structure with a fleshy plumpness and already shows great maturity. Drinking extremely well now.

*Clos de Vougeot Grand Cru 2004* £150.00

The inherent complexities and grandeur of this wine is very evident, it has great finesse and a laciness that provides a wonderfully long finish.

**Sine Qua Non**

No one is quite as obsessed with winemaking as Manfred Krankl. Take that, add in exceptional talent, humility and top notch vineyards and you can begin to understand just how special these wines are. This is an extremely rare chance to taste these wines that have scored as high as 100 points in Wine Advocate.

*Atlantis Syrah 2005* £180.00

Sweet blackberry, charcoal and chocolate aromas. Full bodied with intense blackberry and graphite on the palette. Stunningly long finish.

**Michele Satta**

Michele Satta is one of the rising stars of Italian Wine. His vineyards in Bolgheri are very close to the illustrious Ornellaia. His wines are simply awesome and now consistently feature amongst the top wines in the world. I Castagni has beaten Sassicaia in numerous blind tastings this year.

*Cavaliere 2000* £40.00

This wine is unusual for Bolgheri in that it is made from 100% Sangiovese grapes resulting in a wine that has a delicacy and finesse comparable to Burgundy.

*Syrah 2006* £65.00

This syrah is incredibly small production and exclusive to Hawksmoor in the U.K. A powerful but incredibly well balanced Syrah. Great fruit, acidity and spice really showcase the talents of the winemaker.

*I Castagni 2003* £85.00

This blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah and Teroldego comes from the grapes grown exclusively in the I Castagni Vineyard. Only a few thousand bottles are produced each year and the quality is exceptional.

**Ramon Bilbao**

This family run Bodega has been producing quality wines since 1924 and this year was voted the top winery in Spain. From entry level reds like the Rioja Black label that we serve by the glass to the top wine Mirto the accolades just keep rolling in.

*Pleiades XVI* £55.00  
 Grenache, Syrah, Mouvedre and Barbera, to name just a few, are blended under the trees in deepest darkest Marin County. Luscious mouth feel with bright fruit and spice.
